## DUST CONTROL APPLICATION – 2023 SEASON

**Product Used:** Magnesium Chloride

- **Application and payment must be received in our office by April 14<sup>th</sup>.**
- Specific application dates are based on when the County has prepared the roads and authorized us to begin spraying. Dates are subject to change and are impacted by weather. The first application occurs Mid-May through Mid-June. The second is approximately 60 days after the first application.
- Applicant agrees to maintain flags to mark outer limits of the area to be treated. **Flags must be in place April 14<sup>th</sup> until October 31<sup>st</sup>.** Failure to do this could result in the area being bladed. Neither the County nor Heffron Services assume any liability if your flags are not in place. If area is not marked, drivers will either center on your house or use their best judgment for location.
- Our trucks are equipped with computer equipment that allows us to spray the exact amount of footage ordered. If your flags are set longer than the footage paid for, your dust control will not reach both flags. If your flags are set shorter than the footage paid for, your dust control will extend past your flags.
- The county reserves the right to blade the treated area to maintain the public safety. Your road will be bladed after October 1<sup>st</sup>.
- Heffron Services, Inc. does not guarantee the performance of the product due to factors such as weather, surface preparation, gravel materials, heavy traffic patterns and maintenance of the roadway.
- **Include payment with this application.** We will cash your check after the first application, or May 15<sup>th</sup> whichever is earlier.

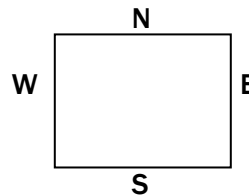

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**CONDITIONS OF PERMIT:**

The application and maintenance of chemicals on crushed rock surfaced roads to control dust shall be by permit only, and in accordance with the below Grundy County Fugitive Dust Control Policy and the applicant agrees to the following conditions:

1. Dust control chemicals may be applied by an approved contractor and/or landowner.
2. Materials approved for use on the roads include calcium chloride, and lignin sulfonate.
3. The landowner shall be responsible for maintaining potholes and rough spots in areas applied with dust control chemicals. Should grading or blading of any dust control treated roadway become necessary by the opinion of the County due to unsafe roadway surface or weather related conditions, such grading or blading will be done by the County without notice and no refund of application costs or retreatment of surface will be made.
4. County Engineer's Office (319/824-6912) shall be notified 5 working days in advance of applying a dust control agent, so the roadway may be properly shaped.
5. Grundy County will not assume responsibility for any dust control service.
6. Grundy County will blade through dust control areas during the month of October to prepare road for winter, without notice to landowner.
