DUST CONTROL APPLICATION – 2022 SEASON

Product Used: Magnesium Chloride

- **Application and payment must be received in our office by April 18th.**
- Specific application dates are based on when the County has prepared the roads and authorized us to begin spraying. Dates are subject to change and are impacted by weather. The first application occurs Mid-May through Mid-June. The second is approximately 60 days after the first application.
- Applicant agrees to maintain flags to mark outer limits of the area to be treated. **Flags must be in place April 18th until October 31st.** Failure to do this could result in the area being bladed. Neither the County nor Heffron Services assume any liability if your flags are not in place. If area is not marked, drivers will either center on your house or use their best judgment for location.
- Our trucks are equipped with computer equipment that allows us to spray the exact amount of footage ordered. If your flags are set longer than the footage paid for, your dust control will not reach both flags. If your flags are set shorter than the footage paid for, your dust control will extend past your flags.
- The county reserves the right to blade the treated area to maintain the public safety. Your road will be bladed after October 1st.
- Heffron Services, Inc. does not guarantee the performance of the product due to factors such as weather, surface preparation, gravel materials, heavy traffic patterns and maintenance of the roadway.
- **Include payment with this application.** We will cash your check after the first application, or May 15th whichever is earlier.

MAHASKA COUNTY GUIDELINES

1. Petroleum products and used oil are not allowed.
2. Width of application must be at least 20 feet wide.
3. Permit applicant is responsible for placing and maintaining flags as well as "DUST CONTROL" signs at each end of the treated surface. County is not responsible for broken or damaged signs.
4. The County reserves the right to blade the road at any time and is not responsible for lost dust control.
5. The permit is valid until **October 1, 2022**, after that date, Mahaska County will blade or rock the road as needed for winter preparation.
6. Mahaska County has no obligation and will assume no responsibility for the dust control product or application. Complaints regarding the performance of the dust control product should be directed to the applicator.
